



Chevron Throw

A gorgeous and colorful chevron blanket worked in garter stitch and four contrasting colors. Use different colors to create a unique throw for everyone in your family.

MATERIALS

Knitting loom

Regular gauge, 198 peg. Sample made on the Super Afghan Loom

Yarn

Approx 1600 yards of worsted weight yarn. Sample shown in Lion Brand Cotton Ease; shades: (A) Terracotta, (B) Cactus, (C) Snow, (D) Seaspray x 3 skeins of each

Notions

Knitting tool, tapestry needle, crochet hook US size J (6 mm)

Gauge

9 sts x 18 rows = 2 in (5 cm) over stockinette stitch

Size

44 x 56 in (112 x 142 cm)

Abbreviations

For a list of common abbreviations see page 61

k2tog Knit 2 stitches together
kfb Knit into the front and back of 1 stitch
ssk slip, slip, knit

STITCH PATTERNS

Chevron Stitch (worked over 16 rows)

Rows 1 and 3: With A, *k2tog, k4, kfb, k1, kfb, k4, ssk; rep from * to end.

Rows 2 and 4: Purl.

Rows 5 and 7: With B, *k2tog, k4, kfb, k1, kfb, k4, ssk; rep from * to end.

Rows 6 and 8: Purl.

Rows 9 and 11: With C, *k2tog, k4, kfb, k1, kfb, k4, ssk; rep from * to end.

Rows 10 and 12: Purl.

Rows 13 and 15: With D, *k2tog, k4, kfb, k1, kfb, k4, ssk; rep from * to end.

Rows 14 and 16: Purl.

These 16 rows form the Chevron Pattern and are repeated throughout.

Tip: Move the stitches first to create the empty pegs needed.

STITCH BREAKDOWN

Over 15 pegs, the breakdown is as follows, row is worked from right to left (clockwise):

Move stitch from peg 1 to 2.

Move stitch from peg 3 to 2.

Move stitch from peg 4 to 3.

Move stitch from peg 5 to 4.

Move stitch from peg 6 to 5.

Peg 6 is empty.

Peg 7 has a stitch, leave it as is.

Peg 8 has a stitch, leave it as is.

Lift loop from peg 15 and hold it.

Move stitch from peg 14 and place it on peg 15.

Place loop that you are holding from * back on peg 15.

Move stitch from peg 13 to 14.

Move stitch from peg 12 to 13.

Move stitch from peg 11 to 12.

Move stitch from peg 10 to 11.

Move stitch from peg 9 to 10.

Work the row as instructed.

INSTRUCTIONS

With A, cast on 195 sts and prepare to work a flat panel.

Commence Chevron pattern changing color every 4 rows.

TIP: When changing color, cut yarn leaving a 6 in (15 cm) tail and weave ends in as you work along the row.

Rep Rows 1–16 of Chevron Stitch pattern until panel measures approx 55 in (140 cm) from cast-on edge.

Bind off loosely with basic bind off method.

Weave ends in.

Block blanket.

FINISHING

Using crochet hook, crochet a single crochet border around blanket to stabilize it.
